Dear TDOT,

The Knoxville Regional TPO requests concurrence by TDOT to adjust the FY 2017-2020 TIP concerning the following projects:

Adjustment 17-2017-207 (KAT Purchase of Neighborhood Service Bus) - Adjust project by splitting the local match in half between state and local match for FY 2018. The revised state and local matches for FY 2018 are \$11,380 and \$11,380 for line item one, and \$12,899 and \$12,899 for line item two.

Adjustment 17-2017-210 (KAT Bus Engine Overhauls) - Adjust project by splitting the local match in half between state and local match for FY 2018. The revised state and local matches for FY 2018 are \$25,000 and \$25,000.

Adjustment 17-2017-211 (KAT Purchase of Passenger Amenities) - Adjust project by splitting the local match in half between state and local match for FY 2018. The revised state and local matches for FY 2018 are \$33,500 and \$33,500.

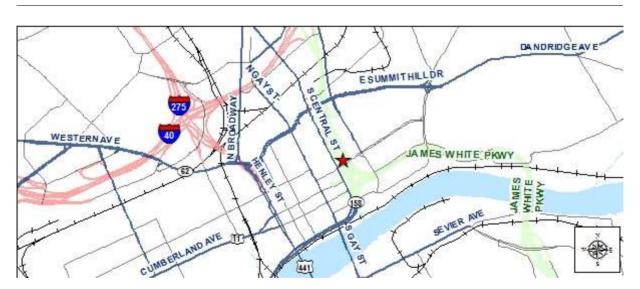

Subject: KAT Request of TDOT to match our "interim round" 2018 LSTBG projects

Hi Matthew:

Hope you had a great Easter and your week is going well so far.

Knoxville Area Transit (KAT) is again busy securing grant funding to keep Knoxville moving. This time we applied for Local Surface Transportation Block Grants (L-STBG). The TPO conducted a "Call for Projects" for the balance of L-STBG funding for FY 2018. KAT was successful with 3 projects and the TPO has allocated the federal share from L-STBG funding to KAT for these grants. The federal share is 80%. These projects are in the TIP.

KAT would like to make a request of TDOT to provide half the local match for these 2018 L-STBG transit projects, for a total state match of \$69,880 for the 3 projects.

We will need to make application in TrAMS so that FTA can issue grant award contracts.
