SUBJECT: Revised Adjustment to project 17-2014-001 (I-275 Business/Industrial Park Access Improvements)

Dear TDOT,

The Knoxville Regional TPO requests concurrence by TDOT to adjust the FY 2017-2020 TIP concerning the following project:

Adjustment 17-2014-001 (I-275 Business/Industrial Park Access Improvements) - Adjust project to correct project description, schedule, funding amounts, and project total to reflect current information. Construction schedule is revised from FY 2017 to FY 2019 at a total cost of \$5,323,040. HPP federal funding of \$3,440,000 includes \$540,500 from prior obligated phases. The funds will be de-obligated and applied to construction phase. This adjustment also adds private funding for non-participating utility work associated with the construction phase. The total project cost is increased to \$6,647,415. Note that the original project total was incorrectly listed as \$6,000,000 instead of \$5,624,375. The revised project total represents reduced prior phase costs costs (-\$1,107,437), added private utility costs (+\$1,023,040), and revisions to the construction estimate (+\$675,625). It is also inclusive of \$431,812 total HPP funds (\$345,450 federal) that remain available for project costs.


